They are intended for safety, health and environmental (SHE) practitioners, middle management and persons managing the occupational safety of any workplace, industry or large office.

The SHE skills programmes assist learners to identify, monitor, advise and report on occupational, health and environmental safety factors, which may have a detrimental effect on the safety of workers in the business or the workplace.
